We are *once again* offering the occasion for pilgrims to receive two Plenary Indulgences (* see below). Our motor coach will take us to visit the Shrine of Blessed Kateri Tekakwitha and the North American Martyrs Shrine in New York on our way east. We will view awesome fall foliage as we travel through the beautiful Berkshire Mountains in Massachusetts. A full day at the National Shrine of the Divine Mercy in Stockbridge, Massachusetts, will offer opportunities for quiet and meditation, Holy Mass, Rosary, and other devotions. On a side trip to the historic Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Boston as guests of the Healing and Restoration Ministry, we will attend a healing service with Fr. Robert Lennon, C.S.R. Our last evening will be a special treat—dinner at Longfellow’s Wayside Inn established in 1716--the oldest operating inn in the country.
